The CTA Executive Committee is requesting your help in making this our most successful annual technology summit yet! Please ensure our workshops meet the needs of our members by submitting your ideas, topics, and workshop sessions for our Annual Technology Summit.

The theme for this year's summit will be *Corrections Technology – On Track for Success*. Consistent with that theme, the CTA Executive Committee is structuring a program that will be very relevant for Correctional Administrators, Corrections' Chief Information Officers and technology staff.

Technology solutions workshops will be presented within the following three tracks:

- During their presentation, sponsors may indicate that they have a booth at the conference; however, under no circumstances are you allowed to market or promote specific products or services in breakout sessions.
- Each breakout session room will be equipped with a laptop PC, LCD projector, and screen.
- The CTA conference committee must receive an electronic copy of all PowerPoint presentations in advance of the conference.
